Like something? ----- STATE IT


Want something? ----- ASK FOR IT

- Nobody will know what's going on in your mind. It's better to express rather than to expect. You already have the NO; take the risk of getting the YES. We only have one life. Keep it simple!




## Champagne Bites

Pop open some bottles of champagne for these Champagne Bites. They're just what the adults want for the holiday season. Make these Champagne Bites for your next party, whether you're celebrating a birthday, New Year's Eve or just because! It takes 15 minutes to prepare and 3 hours to set.

### INGREDIENTS:

- 3 env. (1/4 oz. each) KNOX Unflavored Gelatin
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1 bottle (750 mL) sweet sparkling white wine
- 1/4 cup white sparkling decorating sugar



### DIRECTIONS:

1. Combine gelatin and granulated sugar in large microwaveable bowl. Stir in wine. Let stand 3 min. or until gelatin is softened. Microwave on HIGH 3 min. or until gelatin and sugar are dissolved, stirring after each minute.
2. Pour into 8-inch square pan sprayed with cooking spray. Refrigerate 3 hours or until firm.
3. Dip bottom of pan in warm water 15 sec. Unmold gelatin mixture onto cutting board. Cut gelatin into 5 rows, then cut each row into 5 pieces. Top with sprinkles.

Note – you may substitute sparkling grape juice for the champagne.

### Easy White Chili with Ground Turkey

-- a Butterball Recipe --

#### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Tbsp. olive oil
- 1 pound ground turkey
- 3/4 cup onions, finely diced
- 2 tsp. fresh garlic, minced
- 2 (15 oz.) cans Great Northern beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 (15 oz.) can chickpeas, drained
- 1 & 1/2 cups turkey or chicken broth
- 1 (4 oz.) can chopped mild green chiles, drained
- 3 Tbsp. finely chopped fresh jalapeno peppers
- 1 Tbsp. ground cumin
- 1 tsp. paprika
- 1 tsp. oregano
- 1/4 tsp. cayenne pepper
- Green onion and radishes, sliced for garnish (optional)
- Avocado and cilantro, chopped, for garnish (optional)

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Heat oil in medium-size heavy saucepan over medium-high heat. Add ground turkey; cook and stir until crumbled.
2. Add remaining ingredients, except garnishes. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat. Lower heat to a simmer; cook 25 to 30 minutes.
3. Serve topped with green onions, radishes, avocado and cilantro, if desired.

## **Chocolate Drizzle Chex™ Mix**

### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 6 Tbsp. Margarine or butter (do not use spread or tub products)
- 3 Tbsp. light corn syrup
- 1/4 tsp. baking soda
- 4 cups Corn Chex™ cereal
- 4 cups Rice Chex™ cereal
- 1/4 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup broken pretzels (optional)
- 1/2 cup honey roasted nuts

### **DIRECTIONS:**

1. Cover cookie sheet with wax or parchment paper.
2. In a large microwaveable bowl, microwave brown sugar, margarine and corn syrup. Heat 1 to 2 minutes, stirring each minute. Add baking soda.
3. Stir in cereals (and pretzels and nuts if desired). Microwave on high for 3 minutes, stirring each minute. Spread on cookie sheet. Cool 10 minutes. Break into bite-size pieces.
4. Microwave chocolate chips in small bowl (1 minute or so until chocolate is smooth and melted). Drizzle over the snack mix.
5. Refrigerate 30 minutes until chocolate is set. Store in air tight container.

## Original Chex™ Mix

### INGREDIENTS:

- 3 Tbsp. Margarine or butter (do not use spread or tub products)
- 1 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
- 3/4 tsp. seasoned salt
- 1/4 tsp. garlic powder (NOT garlic salt)
- 1/4 cup onion powder (NOT onion salt)
- 1 1/2 cups Corn Chex™ cereal
- 1 1/2 cups Rice Chex™ cereal
- 1 1/2 cups Wheat Chex™ cereal
- 1/2 cup mixed nuts
- 1/2 cup bite-size pretzels
- 1/2 cup garlic-flavor bite-size bagel chips or regular-size bagel chips, broken into 1-inch pieces

### DIRECTIONS:

1. In large microwavable bowl, microwave butter uncovered on High about 30 seconds or until melted.
2. Stir in seasonings. Gradually stir in remaining ingredients until evenly coated.
3. Microwave uncovered on High 4 to 5 minutes, thoroughly stirring every 2 minutes. Spread on paper towels to cool, about 5 minutes. Store in airtight container.



- Brain cells, hair cells and skin cells – they all die constantly, but freaking fat cells seem to have eternal life.


