The Baltimore LAND CRUISE at Best Western Feb 25-27, 2022, Baltimore, MD is a go! The committee can't wait for you to come "aboard". This will be a fun event that you won't want to miss. The hotel staff will be doing everything they can to try to prevent the spread of COVID. There will be a set number of seats/places at each table. Please DO NOT add people or chairs to your tables during the meal gatherings. We need to be as socially-distanced as space affords us. You may choose to meet up with your RH friends during the reception, at bingo, the hospitality room, or in the lounge.

Vaccinations and pre-testing are <u>not</u> required. **WHY?** The committee discussed the fact that, at this point, <u>anybody</u>– vaxed or unvaxed people – can catch the virus and/or pass it to others. This means that if only vaxed people come to any event, you or others may still be vulnerable to the virus. The committee chose not to exclude anyone.

If you plan to go to locations away from the Best Western for dining or shopping, you need to bring your vaccination card with you. Some establishments may not let you enter without showing your vaccination card.

Currently, Baltimore City requires everyone to wear masks in all public spaces. A mask will be provided to you in your registration bag, so please plan on wearing your mask at all times when you are in common areas (elevator, dining rooms, etc.) where multiple people are gathered. Masks may be removed for eating and drinking. We request your cooperation in wearing your mask so the spread of colds or COVID are lessened.

#### To Be or Not to Be Vaxed:

According to doctors, some version of COVID-19 is going to be with us for years to come. The virus and its variants do not care whether you are vaxed. It's very scary but we must be able to tolerate other peoples' choices. The alternative is to stay home and live in fear.

Prior to COVID19, we always had to deal with the common cold or seasonal flu. Few people stayed home when they were sick. They went to work, church, shopping, etc. Prior to Jan 2020, nobody wore masks or cared to stay home rather than risk catching some cold or virus. We didn't bother to stay away from those who did not get the yearly flu shot nor did we exclude them from attending outings with family and friends. We relied on their sense of consideration for others to stay home and not pass on their germs.

The pandemic changed all that. Masks may or may not be required from time to time in various areas or establishments. Whether you like it or not, whether you agree with it or not, please be considerate of others and obedient to the venue's health requirements. Wear your mask when required while you are out and about. If you are sick, stay home.

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#### Let Me See Your Vaccine Card:

What a can of worms this statement is. Did you know that the only place you, yourself, may demand to see a vaccine card is when someone comes to your own home? It's true.

## Let Me See Your Vaccine Card (Continued):

As a hostess of a Red Hat event, legally you may not require attendees to present a vaccine card UNLESS the establishment in which you are holding the event requires that all persons entering that establishment be vaccinated – thus they may be required to show proof of vaccination. There are very few of those places.

Many states have different mandates and protocols, so before booking an event for Red Hatters, check with the venue to determine its policy regarding masks and vaccine cards. Especially check with theatres when booking show reservations.

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#### "I Want a Full Refund."

#### **A Note to Event Hostesses:**

Not all of the announcements for Red Hat events include information about whether a Red Hatter or guest can get their money back if they do not attend an event for which they paid. It is "understood" that a person who misses a luncheon will not be given a refund. How about a two or three-day event? Hostesses, do yourselves a favor and avoid any arguments or ugly confrontations; include something about refunds – full or partial -- on ALL event announcements you send out, regardless of how many days the event is.

## A Note to All Who Register for Events:

We are all aware of the pandemic. We all know the risk of signing up for events at any

time. We know when we go to any public place, we encounter people who are not wearing masks and who may not be vaccinated. We choose whether to enter.

We each choose for ourselves what risks we are willing to take when we sign up for events. If you are fearful of encountering someone who hasn't been vaccinated, then perhaps you should not sign up for events.

Beware of the NO REFUNDS clause in any announcement. If that exists, then don't ask for a refund when you cancel your reservation. Many announcements say "NO REFUNDS; you may transfer your registration to someone else" (in other words, try to sell your reservation to someone else).

If the announcement does NOT contain refund information, and you choose to cancel within six months of an event, DO NOT expect to get a full refund. Your planners/ hostesses must spend money for the venue, table favors, entertainment, etc. months in advance. Whether you cancel or come, that money has been spent on everyone who registered.

We each make our own choice to sign up. We each must bear the consequences if we decide to cancel.

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### Let Me See Your Vaccine Card:

What a can of worms this statement is. Did you know that the only place you, yourself, may legally demand to see a vaccine card is when someone is entering into your own living space/property? It's true.

## Let Me See Your Vaccine Card (Continued):

As a host(ess) of an event, you may <u>not</u> require attendees to present a vaccine card UNLESS the establishment in which you are holding the event requires that all persons entering that establishment be vaccinated. Your announcement/flyer may ask that only those who have been vaccinated attend but, again, you are not guaranteeing safety for your guests because vaccinated people too could pass on the virus.

Many states have different mandates and protocols, so before booking an event for Red Hatters, check with the venue to determine its policy regarding masks and vaccine cards. Especially check with theatres when booking show reservations.

This pandemic still exists, according to the CDC. We all need to be careful. As a Red Hatter, I am ready to get back out there and have some fun. I am vaxed and boosted and I wear my mask. I do my best to attend events where social distancing is possible.

In Maryland, our positivity rate jumped from 30% in mid-Jan to just over 10% on Jan 29. Our rate continues to drop and by the end of Feb, when the Red Hat Land Cruise "disembarks" in Baltimore, MD, I am hopeful that the rate will be at 5% or less.

### 10 Items to Have on Hand in Case You (or Someone You Live with) Test Positive for Coronavirus

#### 1. Your Doctor's Phone Number

Call the office's nurse or physician's assistant to check in and ask if they have any guidance about the best person to contact in case any coronavirus symptoms arise.

#### 2. A Bonus Refill on Prescriptions

While you're speaking with someone who works with your doc, inquire about any Rx needs that might require refills within the next month or two. Depending on the medicine and your local pandemic positivity rate, he or she might suggest snagging an extra supply ahead of time.

## 3. The Location of Your Nearest Testing Facility, Plus Some At-Home Test Kits

Go to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services online portal to find a community-based testing location near you. (https://www.hhs.gov/coronavirus/community-based-testing-sites/index.html)
You may also be able to schedule a rapid test through private companies (just Google "rapid coronavirus testing sites near me. At-Home test kits are available through the U.S. Govt at

https://www.covidtests.gov/

If you think you have COVID but can't get find a test, the best plan of action is to act as if you are positive and stay home.

#### 4. A Thermometer

One of the most common symptoms of any infection is a high temperature; a signal your

white blood cells are attacking foreign invaders. Use a thermometer to monitor your internal temperature and the temperature of everyone in your household if someone falls ill. (Bonus points if you snag a different thermometer per person! Either way, be sure to clean the thermometer between each use.)

#### 5. Cough Drops

Coughing is another frequently reported reaction to the virus, so invest in a bag or two of cough drops to calm that and potentially aid an ailing throat.

#### 6. Disinfectant Sprays

It's best for infected individuals to quarantine away from family members. That might not always be completely possible (a shared bathroom), so keep the windows open, if possible, disinfect high-touch surfaces daily and disinfect any surface after the infected individual may have come into contact with it.

#### 7. Disinfectant Wipes

Clorox and Lysol wipes have also been proven to combat bacteria and viruses. Did you know you can even use these on most phones?

#### 8. Soup

According to *EatingWell* staff dietitians, one of the best things to eat if you have coronavirus is soup. Before you get sick, make a big batch of a healthy soup recipe to freeze in single servings or buy low-sodium store-bought options to feed your body while it's hard at work attempting to recover.

#### 9. Tea

Tea is not only great for hydration, but its warm temperature can help ease congestion—a symptom some coronavirus-positive individuals report.

#### 10. Hand Soap

One of the most popular refrains from these past few pandemic-ridden years: Wash your hands! Good old soap and water is even more effective than hand sanitizer in most cases—as long as you wash your hands properly and often enough.

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#### Free masks are on the way to

**pharmacies:** As the government sends free COVID tests to households across the nation, 400 million free N95 masks are also on their way.

Unlike the free testing kits which are ordered through a government website or hotline and shipped by the United States Postal Service, the free N95 masks will be available to pick up at "tens of thousands" of pharmacies and community health centers that have partnered with the federal government's COVID-19 vaccination campaign.

Check with your local pharmacies, senior adult activity centers or community centers.

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## Dehydration: By: Arnaldo Liechtenstein, physician

Whenever I teach clinical medicine to students in the fourth year of medicine, I ask the following question: What are the causes of mental confusion in the elderly? Some offer: "Tumors in the head". I answer: No!

Others suggest: "Early symptoms of Alzheimer's". I answer No! With each rejection of their answers, their responses dry up. And they are even more open-mouthed when I list the three most common causes:

- uncontrolled diabetes
- urinary infection
- dehydration

It may sound like a joke, but it isn't. People over 60 generally stop feeling thirsty and consequently stop drinking fluids. When no one is around to remind them to drink fluids, they quickly dehydrate.

Dehydration is severe and affects the entire body It may cause abrupt mental confusion, a drop in blood pressure, increased heart palpitations, angina (chest pain), coma and even death.

This habit of forgetting to drink fluids begins at age 60, when we have just over 50% of the water we should have in our bodies. People

over 60 have a lower water reserve. This is part of the natural ageing process, but there are more complications. Although they are dehydrated, they don't feel like drinking water, because their internal balance mechanisms don't work very well.

#### Conclusion:

People over 60 years old dehydrate easily, not only because they have a smaller water supply, but also because they do not feel the lack of water in the body. Although people over 60 may look healthy, the performance of reactions and chemical functions can damage their entire body.

#### So here are two alerts:

- 1) Get into the habit of drinking liquids: Liquids include water, juices, teas, coconut water, milk, soups, and water-rich fruits, such as watermelon, melon, peaches and pineapple; orange and tangerine also work. The important thing is that every two hours, you must drink some liquid. Remember this!
- 2) Alert for family members: constantly offer fluids to people over age 60. At the same time, observe them. If you realize that they are rejecting liquids and, from one day to the next, they are irritable, breathless or display a lack of attention, these are almost certainly recurrent symptoms of dehydration

Inspired to drink more water now? Pass this article on to your friends and family, especially if they are 60 or over or are caring for someone 60 or over.

4 eggs

1 cup water

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Beat all ingredients for 4 minutes on High Speed. Butter and flour the Bundt cake pan, even if it is non-stick, to ensure a perfect mold, and bake at 325 degrees for 50 minutes.
- 2. Decorate with dripped icing or powered sugar or any kind of fruit.



#### **Cumin-Coconut Roasted Carrots**

### **Ingredients:**

- 3 pounds carrots (peeled and diced (or substitute carrots with kabocha squash)
- 3 tablespoons maika'l coconut butter (melted)
- 2 tablespoons cumin seeds
- 8 cloves garlic (minced)
- 3 tablespoons cilantro (chopped)
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper



#### **Directions:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 400F.
- 1.In a large mixing bowl, combine carrots, melted coconut butter, cumin, salt, pepper and garlic. Toss well to combine.
- 2. Transfer the carrot mixture to a lined baking sheet and arrange in one layer. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes or until tender, giving it a light stir halfway through cooking.
- 3. Before serving, sprinkle with cilantro.



### **Hot Cheetos Esquites**

2 cups corn (fresh or frozen)


2 tablespoons mayonnaise

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Heat oil in a non-stick pan on medium-low.
- 2. Add corn to pan and cook until softened.
- 3. Add mayonnaise and mix with corn.
- 4. Remove from heat and top with cheese, lime juice and Hot Cheeto dust.

#### **Beef Luau**

Beef Chuck

### Ingredients:

2 pounds fresh luau leaves, stems removed and stemless leaves coarsely chopped (you may sub with frozen luau leaves)

2 pounds beef chuck, cut into 2" cubes (short ribs or stew meat also works)

2 tablespoons vegetable oil

1 pound yellow onion, sliced 1/2 inch

Hawaiian Salt, to taste



Lugu Leaves

#### Lomi Tomato (Optional)

2 ripe tomatoes, diced into 1/4 inch pieces

1/2 tennis ball sized sweet onion, finely minced

1/4 cup green onions, finely sliced

1 pinch Hawaiian salt

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Heat a heavy-bottomed pot on the stove on high. Season the beef with Hawaiian salt.
- 1. Add just enough oil to the pot to lightly coat the bottom. When the oil is hot enough to shimmer and gives off wisps of steam, add the beef in small batches to avoid overcrowding and brown well. Remove browned beef, add next batch and continue until all beef is browned.
- 2. Pour out most of the rendered fat from the pot, leaving just enough to coat the bottom. Add onions, lower heat to medium and cook, stirring occasionally, until onions are sweet and translucent.

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### Beef Luau (continued)

4. Layer the luau leaves on top of onion. Add browned beef on top of the luau leaves to weigh them down, add water, cover. Bring up to a boil, then lower to very low, and simmer until the beef is very tender and the luau leaves are very soft. Taste and adjust with salt, chili pepper water and water if needed.

Note: Alternatively, you may pre-blanch and drain the luau leaves in a separate pot of salted water to speed up the cooking and help to wilt the greens so they fit in the pot with the beef more easily.

#### **Lomi Tomato**

- 1. Combine ingredients, add in a few ice cubes to chill down and add to sauce.
- 2. Serve.

#### **Optional Ingredients for Lomi Tomato**

2 dry opae (dry shrimp), chopped

1 clove garlic chopped

#### **Chili Pepper Water (Optional)**

#### Ingredients

2 cups water

2 cloves garlic

5 fresh chilies (Hawaiian or Thai Chili Peppers work best)

Pinch of salt

Vinegar, to taste

#### **Directions**

- 1. Combine water, garlic, chilies and salt and bring to a boil.
- 2. Boil until all ingredients are soft and mushy, then remove from heat and puree.
- 3. Adjust seasoning if needed, then add vinegar to taste.





"Yes," he replied. "She sells C cells by the Seashore."


